The Meritorious Service Award (MSA) is OEMAC's official recognition of individuals who have made exemplary contributions to the growth and development of occupational and environmental medicine. Fields include contributions to OHS legislation, worker health and safety, research, education and professional bodies. The MSA is awarded to one or multiple individuals at the Annual Scientific Conference hosted by OEMAC. Nominations received after the Nomination deadline will be considered for the following year.

Awards are made to individuals who, in the opinion of the MSA committee as ratified by the OEMAC executive, have contributed in an exemplary manner to the growth and development of occupational medicine in Canada.

Who can be nominated for the award?

Nominations can be made for individuals who have made contributions to occupational and environmental medicine; this can be members and non-members of OEMAC.

Who can nominate an individual for the award?

The nominator must be a member in good standing with OEMAC.

How do I nominate someone?

Return the completed nomination form to the OEMAC office by the deadline. The form requires you to provide information about the nominee and the contribution(s) he or she has made that you feel merit reception of the MSA. If more space is require, please attached the additional information to your submission.

All nominations are confidential.

Recipients will be contacted directly by the OEMAC President and Committee Chairperson. The names of successful candidates will be featured on the OEMAC website's MSA Winners page after the award (s) has been presented.
